Dear friends and fellow laborers,

It is a privilege to once again write a letter to each of you as you faithfully continue in your service of love for our Lord. As I have told you so often, and mean with all of my heart, you are an indispensable part of the work that is being done in Mexico. Without your prayers, love and giving, the ministry would have never been possible, and without its continuance, it will not persevere into the future. May God bless you richly and abundantly for your faithfulness.

Because God has proven himself **faithful** in the past, we now dare to walk in **faith** for today, knowing full well that we dare to have **hope** in this faithful God for tomorrow. It is because of this faithful God that I look forward to the future of the work in Mexico with joy and expectation. Let me bring you quickly up to date on the new developments in the work of **Voice in the Wilderness Ministries**.

On April 5, my father and I left Manitoba for Mexico. It became increasingly my burden that I needed to get back to Cd. Valles in order to spend time with Ezequiel and Veronica, as well as with the church. Until that point, it had not been advisable for me to attempt to reenter Mexico. However, with the assurance that I was completely cleared to do so, we entered without any complications or problems and it seems apparent that the door is once again open for continued, unimpeded ministry into the Huasteca.

Along with the continuation of the on-going work in the Huasteca, one of the things that has been planted in our hearts is the linking of American churches with villages in Mexico. We are calling this ministry "**Pueblo Partnership**". The vision for these partnerships is to link American churches with a specific unreached village in the Huasteca of Mexico. The American church, working in conjunction with pastor Ezequiel and the local church in Cd. Valles "adopts" a village and makes a long-term commitment to send teams at least every six months to evangelize, to send finances so that a native missionary can visit the village on a weekly basis, and to see the planting of a viable Church in the village. After a vital Church has begun in the pueblo, the American church will then help to build a simple structure in which the new Body can meet. The commitment continues until the newly planted work itself reaches out to plant new missions in its neighboring villages; thus, once birthed, it also gives birth to others.

Please pray about this as a Church Body to see if this is the challenge that God is placing before you. Imagine what could happen in the Kingdom if each American Church would partner in this way with even just one Mexican pueblo. What an impact we could make in the fields which are right now white and ready for harvest.

We continue to covet your prayers as the work continues to advance and grow. It seems apparent that at this time we cannot continue to safely minister through medical clinics and this will certainly make some changes in how the work is done. However, God is opening other doors for us to use to minister and to touch lives. God is a big and faithful Father. May God bless you abundantly.
